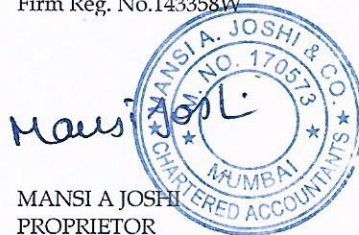

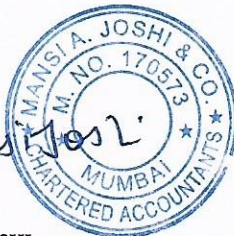

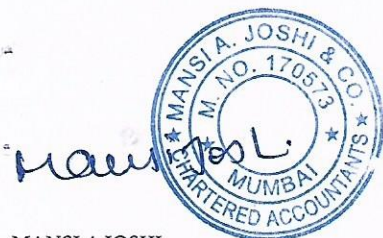

- f) The Manager or Trustee or any other person required by us to appear before us did so and furnished the necessary information required by us.





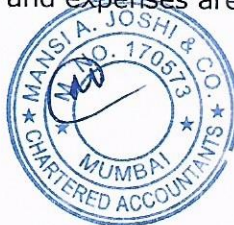

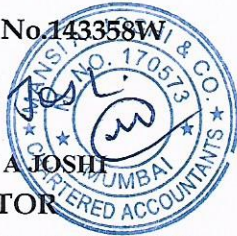
